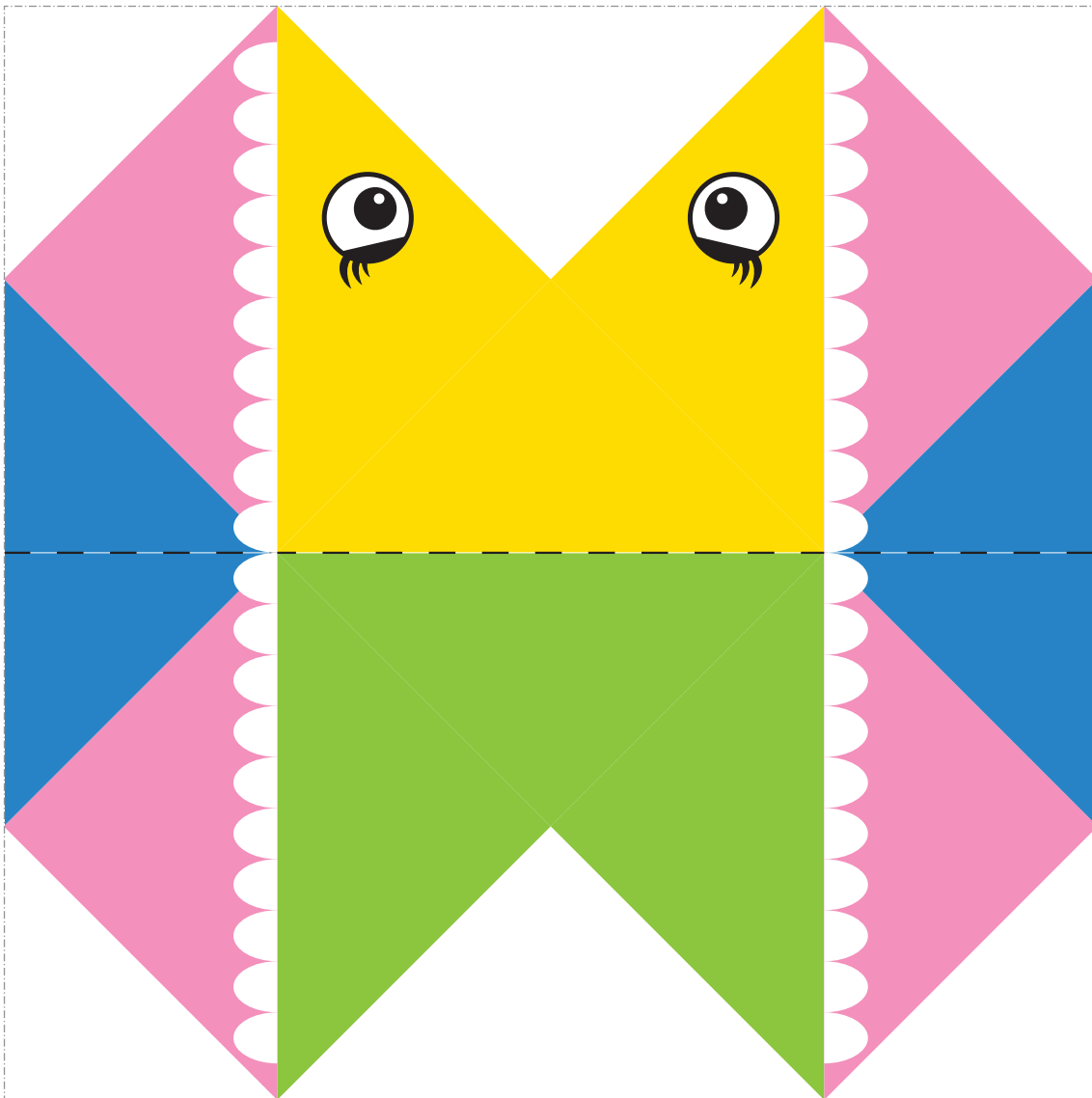
Cut out the strands of hair and stick to your puppet.

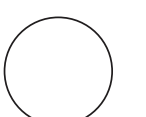
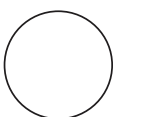
